- God is bringing His people to His place for His purpose.

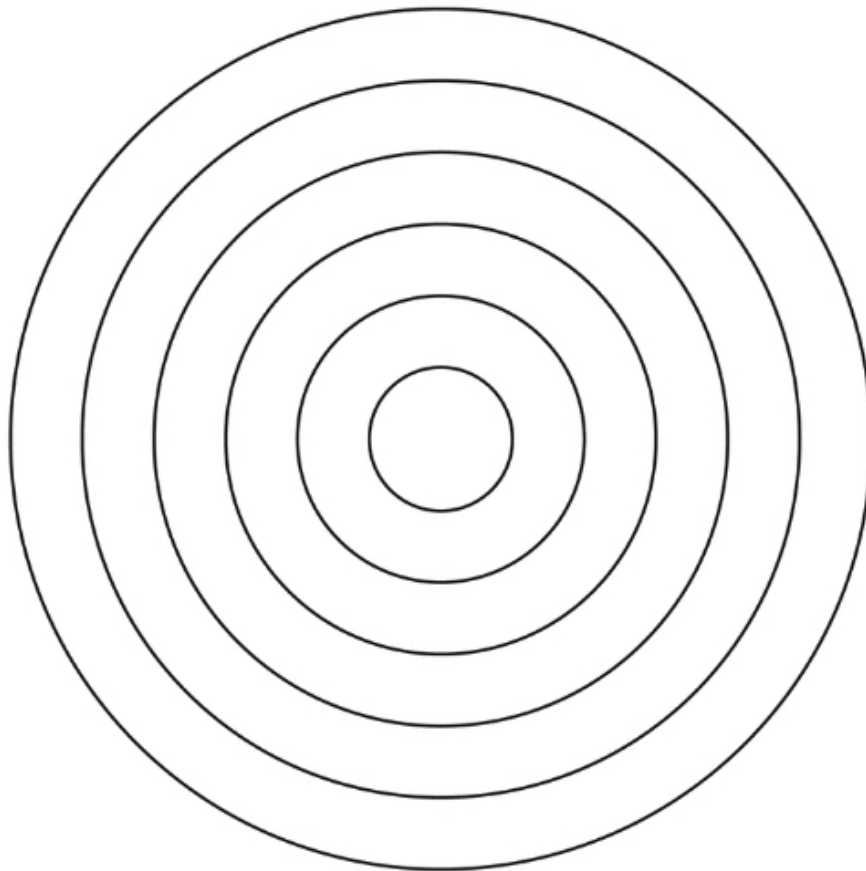
Walking with God...
