

SHOULD I ATTEND A SAME-SEX CEREMONY?

Like many other questions on this “Sexuality Resources” page (mcleanbible.org/sexuality), we don’t have a specific chapter and verse we can go to in the Bible that offers a direct answer to this question. That doesn’t mean the Bible isn’t helpful, for God’s Word contains everything we need to grow in Christlikeness and glorify God in our lives. Therefore, we must take into account all that the Bible does teach and ask for God’s Spirit to guide us with His wisdom accordingly. In our attempts to do so, however, we may find ourselves disagreeing with other Bible-believing Christians who are also trying to follow the leadership of God’s Spirit according to God’s Word.

Such disagreement is possible when answering this specific question about whether to attend a same-sex ceremony. For this reason, we want to point you to two resources. We asked two of our pastors to address this question, and both of them responded with different, biblically-informed answers.
