As Elders, Lead Pastors, Location Pastors, and Central Ministry Directors, we want to take extra steps to strive toward healing in our church.

To that end, we strongly encourage active members of our church family to engage in the following two meetings:

1. Special Congregational Meeting online Wednesday, May 18, at 7 pm.

2. June Congregational Meeting online Wednesday, June 1, at 7 pm.

Assuming our church family approves the above "Plan for Lawsuit Resolution," we will vote on elder nominees who have our full support as biblically qualified to lead our church family into the future. Voting on elders, as well as voting on new members, will be available electronically and/or in person for active members June 1-5.
