What does MBC believe? Do you know? Do you have questions about MBC's doctrinal beliefs or wonder why our theological convictions are so strong? If these questions resonate with you, join us for a dynamic course that will delve into the core doctrinal beliefs outlined in our Constitution. Across two, four-week sessions, we will explore the essential topics of our collective faith and spiritual formation. Session one will focus on "Doctrine of Scripture and the Godhead" and session two will focus on "Salvation and the Church."



WHAT IS A CHURCH GROUP?

At MBC, a Church Group is a group of people who commit to Caring for one another, growing together to become more like Jesus, and Making disciples together on mission in the world ("C-G-M"). Church Groups are designed to be representative of the entire body of Christ, including men and women of all ages and backgrounds, married and single, and families with and without children in the home. Groups meet in all kinds of places and are all different sizes, although they typically range from 3-30 people.

WHY JOIN A CHURCH GROUP?

We want every member of MBC to experience the deep, healthy community that we read about in the New Testament – it's what we were made for. We are committed to caring for the spiritual health of the body of Christ by creating and strengthening opportunities for biblical community for every group member at every MBC location. We believe that Church Groups can help us experience the strengths of a large church and yet offer the family relationships of a small church community so that no one slips through the cracks.

HOW DO I GET STARTED?

There are two ways to connect to a Church Group:

- 1. Attend MBC Connect following any Sunday service. This 10-minute info session is designed to orient you to MBC and answer questions you may have about what it looks like to be involved in the life of our MBC family.
- 2. Go to mcleanbible.org/mocogroups to search for a Church Group that meets in your area. Submit the contact form to connect with the group leaders to learn more.

NURSERY & TODDLERS

NURSERY | NEWBORN - 18 MONTHS

The Nursery helps little ones learn that church is a safe place to experience God's love through God's people. The Nursery uses playing, talking, caregiving, and music to familiarize each child with God's name and His love for them. This helps to lay a foundation for children to know and trust God.

TODDLER | 19 MONTHS - 3 YEARS

The Toddler area encourages children to build a foundation on God's Word through play, Bible stories, crafts and coloring, and a memory verse. We strive to come alongside and support parents as they lead their toddlers to know and follow Christ.

PRESCHOOL AND KINDERGARTEN

3 YEARS - KINDERGARTEN

The Preschool and Kindergarten area encourages children to know, love, and follow God as they hear the Gospel weekly and receive teaching on the basics of Christian faith. We help preschoolers and kindergarteners understand the Bible is not a collection of stories but God's unified story of edemption. Preschoolers and kindergarteners engage in playtime, a Bible lesson and memory verse, group games, and singing.

ELEMENTARY

1ST - 5TH GRADE

In Elementary, we encourage children to grow daily in their personal relationship with Christ by strengthening their foundation in the Bible and helping them become a witness to their family and friends. Elementary kids experience:

- Care: Children and their small group leaders engage in fun activities designed to build lasting relationships with the children.
- Growth: During large group, children participate in discovering God's Word 2. through Bible verse memorization, interactive storytelling techniques, worship, and prayer.
- Discipleship: Children break off into s all groups for a dedicated time of 3. reflection in God's Word through activities and intentional discussion.
- Prayer: Children and leaders join in prayer for each other. 4.

We strongly believe in partnering with parents to disciple their kids. At the end of every Sunday class, students receive "Take-Homes" to help you guide your kids through spiritual discussions at home and reinforce what we talk about each week.

SHORT-TERM MISSION TRIPS






