WHAT IS A CHURCH GROUP?

At MBC, a Church Group is a group of people who commit to Caring for one another, growing together to become more like Jesus, and Making disciples together on mission in the world ("C-G-M"). Church Groups are designed to be representative of the entire body of Christ, including men and women of all ages and backgrounds, married and single, and families with and without children in the home. Groups meet in all kinds of places and are all different sizes, although they typically range from 3-30 people.



NURSERY & TODDLERS

NURSERY | NEWBORN - 18 MONTHS

The Nursery helps little ones learn that church is a safe place to experience God's love through God's people. The Nursery uses playing, talking, caregiving, and music to familiarize each child with God's name and His love for them. This helps to lay a foundation for children to know and trust God.

TODDLER | 19 MONTHS - 3 YEARS

The Toddler area encourages children to build a foundation on God's Word through play, Bible stories, crafts and coloring, and a memory verse. We strive to come alongside and support parents as they lead their toddlers to know and follow Christ.

PRESCHOOL AND KINDERGARTEN

3 YEARS - KINDERGARTEN

The Preschool and Kindergarten area encourages children to know, love, and follow God as they hear the Gospel weekly and receive teaching on the basics of Christian faith. We help preschoolers and kindergarteners understand the Bible is not a collection of stories but God's unified story of redemption. Preschoolers and kindergarteners engage in playtime, a Bible lesson and memory verse, group games, and singing.

ELEMENTARY

1ST - 5TH GRADE

In Elementary, we encourage children to grow daily in their personal relationship with Christ by strengthening their foundation in the Bible and helping them become a witness to their family and friends. Elementary kids experience:

- 1. Care: Children and their small group leaders engage in fun activities designed to build lasting relationships with the children.
- Growth: During large group, children participate in discovering God's Word through Bible verse memorization, interactive storytelling techniques, worship, and prayer.
- 3. Discipleship: Children break off into small groups for a dedicated time of reflection in God's Word through activities and intentional discussion.
- 4. Prayer: Children and leaders join in prayer for each other.

We strongly believe in partnering with parents to disciple their kids. At the end of every Sunday class, children receive "Take-Homes" to help you guide your kids through spiritual discussions at home and reinforce what we talk about each week.



At MBC, our mission is to glorify God by making disciples and multiplying churches among all nations. Involvement in this global mission is not optional: every Christ-follower has a role to play. We surrender our time, talents, resources, and lives for the sake of the lost, the poor, and the vulnerable who need Christ above all. We work to establish new local churches where none currently exist and to strengthen existing local churches. We will prioritize global endeavors that help create gospel access where there is none. We primarily do this through short-term trips, mid to long-term sending, and global partnerships.

SHORT-TERM MISSION TRIPS

MBC sends short-term teams around the world to effectively advance the goals of our long-term partners in places where the gospel is both inaccessible and accessible. The aim of short-term trips is to help establish churches where none exist and strengthen existing local churches.


