SCRIPTURE READING

Genesis 2:15 (ESV)

15 The Lord God took the man and put him in the garden of Eden to work it and keep it. Genesis

ICE BREAKER QUESTION

When you think about work, what positives and negatives come to mind?

SERMON RECAP

Work is using your skills to serve people and care for creation - God is working through your work.

Seven biblical values that should drive a Christian approach to work:

- 1. Work with *purpose* It should be grounded in a general and specific sense of purpose.
- 2. Work with *integrity* Be who you are when nobody and everybody is watching.
- 3. Work with justice Use your power to do what's right and to ensure that all people are treated fairly.
- 4. Work with excellence It's not just what you do, but how you do your work.
- 5. Work with love Always be driven by a commitment to serve the best interest of others.
- 6. Work with a healthy rhythm (rest) Stop to rest and enjoy life outside of work.
- 7. Work on *mission* See your work as an opportunity to share the gospel.

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

Observation: What does this passage say?

- 1. Read Genesis 2:15 aloud as a group. Let group members share observations. Try not to move into interpretation of the passage or application of what you read quite yet. Simply share what you observe.
 - What words jump out at you in verse 15?
 - What verbs (action words) do you see in verse 15?
 - What does God do and what does humanity do in verse 15?
 - How would you summarize Genesis 2:15?

 - · What is the general purpose that God gives humanity in work?
 - What is the specific purpose that God gives humanity in work?
- 2. Read Proverbs 10:9 and 11:3
 - · How does integrity make you secure in your work?
 - · How does integrity guide your work?
- 3. Read Deuteronomy 24:14-15, Proverbs 11:1, and James 5:4
 - · What does it mean to treat everyone fairly or justly like God does?
 - · What does it mean to protect vulnerable or oppressed people?
- 4. Read Colossians 3:23-24
 - · How can working 'heartily' translate into working 'excellently'?
 - · How does excellent work make your heavenly reward sweeter?
- 5. Read Matthew 22:37-39



- · What does it look like to love the Lord through your work?
- · What does it look like to love others through your work?
- 6. Read Genesis 2:2
 - · What does it mean to 'finish' work before you rest?
 - Why is rest and recreation critical following work?
- 7. Read Genesis 3:17-19
 - Why does God curse the environment surrounding man's work?
 - · Why does the physical, mental, or emotional toil of work drain humanity?

 - How does your life reflect justice to all whom you encounter?
 - Describe some ways that you support or protect vulnerable and oppressed people.
- 4. Excellence
 - · How would others describe the quality of your work?
 - How might you inspire others to work excellently, as for the Lord?
- 5. Love
 - How would others see your love for the Lord through your work?
 - How would others see your love for them through your work?
- 6. Rest (Healthy Rhythm)
 - How do you set up work targets so you can enable periods of rest?
 - How does healthy rest contribute to your balance between work and life?
- 7. Mission
 - · What can you do or how can you work to bring regular, routine joy to your work?
 - How are you working on mission by bringing the gospel into your work?
- 8. Church Group
 - How can we incorporate these seven biblical values into our Church Group?
 - How is God working through our Church Group?
 - Are there any changes we need to make to help our Church Group to work better?
