WHAT IS A CHURCH GROUP?

At MBC, a Church Group is a group of people who commit to Caring for one another, Growing together to become more like Jesus, and Making disciples together on mission in the world (“C-G-M”). Church Groups are designed to be representative of the entire body of Christ, including men and women of all ages and backgrounds, married and single, and families with and without children in the home. Groups meet in all kinds of places and are all different sizes, although they typically range from 3-30 people.

We want every member of MBC to experience the deep, healthy community that we read about in the New Testament – it’s what we were made for. We believe that Church Groups can help us experience the strengths of a large church and yet offer the family relationships of a small church community so that no one slips through the cracks.

WHAT CAN I EXPECT IN A CHURCH GROUP?

All Church Groups will look a little different, yet all will include 3 essential elements.

1. All Church Groups commit to building biblical community. To care for one another well, we must know one another. We spend time together and build communities that care for both physical and spiritual needs.
2. All Church Groups commit to spending time together in and around God’s Word. We often discuss sermons from the previous week and help each other apply what we are learning.
3. All Church Groups commit to deeper sharing and prayer. We spend time sharing how we are really doing, supporting one another, and praying for and with each other. We send each other out to make disciples.

HOW DO I GET STARTED?

There are two ways to connect to a Church Group.



KID'S QUEST

FOR NEWBORN TO 5th GRADE CHILDREN

Our Kid's Quest ministry offers programming from newborn through 5th grade children during Sunday worship service times. We engage children with the life-changing truth of the gospel in fun and creative ways. God has ordained parents to be the primary disciplers of their children, so Kid's Quest aims to be supplemental in children's discipleship while supporting parents in their high calling.

FIRST STEPS

Nursery: Birth-17 Months

The Nursery helps little ones learn that church is a safe place to experience God's love through His people. The Nursery uses playing, talking, praying, singing and care-giving to familiarize each child with God's Name and His love for them. This helps to lay a foundation for children to know and trust God as they prepare to move into our toddler classes.

Toddlers: 18 Months- Turning 3 After September

The Toddler area encourages children to build a foundation on God's Word through engaging in play, Bible stories, crafts, worship, prayer, and a monthly memory verse. We strive to come alongside and support parents as they lead their toddlers to know and follow Christ.

EARLY CHILDHOOD

Preschool: 3 Years as of October 1st- Pre-Kindergarten

The Preschool mission is to help preschool children to know, love, and follow God. Through prayer, giving, Bible memory, etc., every lesson teaches that Jesus came to love and forgive sinners. Preschoolers experience:

1. Small Group: A getting-started activity, Bible truth, mission exploration, and an integrating craft.
2. Large Group: A large group time which brings our Bible lesson to life through interactive storytelling and song.

Kindergarten: 5 Years as of October 1st

The kindergarten mission is to help children know, love, and follow God. Through prayer, giving, Bible memory, etc., children are discipled to understand that they are sinners in need of salvation. Every lesson teaches children about Jesus' desire to know them and for them to know Him as their personal Lord and Savior. Kindergarteners experience:

1. Small Group: A getting-started activity, Bible truth, mission exploration, and an integrating craft.
2. Large Group: A large group time which brings our Bible lesson to life through interactive storytelling and song as well as an extended time for age-appropriate discipleship and Gospel presentation.

ELEMENTARY

Lower Elementary: 1st Grade - 3rd Grade

Lower elementary encourages children to grow daily in their personal relationship with Christ by strengthening their foundation in the Bible and helping them become a witness to their family and friends. Elementary kids experience:

1. Care: Children and their small group leaders engage in fun activities designed to create an environment in which leaders build lasting relationships with children.
2. Grow: During large group, children participate in discovering God's Word through Bible verse memorization, interactive storytelling techniques, worship, and prayer.
3. Disciple: Children break off into their small groups for a dedicated time of reflection in God's Word through activities and intentional discussion.
4. Pray: Children and leaders join in prayer for each other.

Upper Elementary: 4th and 5th Grade

Upper elementary equips children to live out their faith in practical ways as they take ownership of their walk with Christ and prepare for middle school. Students are challenged to go deeper in their knowledge of Scripture and to live boldly as disciples of Jesus in their schools, communities, and families. Upper Elementary kids experience:

1. Care: Leaders foster a safe and welcoming environment where students can build lasting friendships and be encouraged in their faith.
2. Grow: Large group gatherings engage students in deeper Bible teaching, Scripture memory, worship, and prayer that connect God's Word to everyday life.
3. Disciple: Small groups give students opportunities to discuss, reflect, and apply God's truth in personal and meaningful ways.
4. Pray: Students are encouraged to pray boldly—both for their own lives and for others—developing confidence in their personal prayer life.


